Each day, Monday to Friday from 9.00am to 5.00pm, your young star will be busy learning and having a ball rehearsing for the show. They will most certainly come home at the end of each day with lots of exciting news to share with the family! On Saturday, it's SHOW TIME ~ we hope to see lots of parents, family members and friends come along to the performance to see what these amazing kids have been working on!

Our musical has been written ESPECIALLY FOR OUR PROGRAM by local music writing legends Scott Maxwell and Mike Bakker. It has never been performed before and we are very excited to bring it to the stage for the first time!

- Dress rehearsals 9 am-12 noon
- Walk to Vansittart Park for lunch and a play (weather dependent)
- Return to theatre at 1pm
- Show starts at 2pm
- Students to go home with parents at the end of the show
- If you are not coming to watch the show, we will notify you on Friday 17th as to what time collection time will be on the Saturday afternoon.

WHAT THE STUDENTS NEEDS TO PACK EACH DAY:

- ALL FOOD for lunch, morning and afternoon tea breaks. Pack plenty of nutritious snacks. The children will be dancing, singing and acting most of the day they will get hungry!!
- **NO NUTS PLEASE!!!** There are children with serious allergies and the Studio will be a NUT FREE ZONE for the week.
- Bring plenty of water. Pack a couple of drink bottles. Students can refill at our taps as needed.
- Wear comfortable **clothing and footwear** that provides for freedom of movement and is appropriate for the weather.
- Make sure that all property is **labelled** to avoid losing things.
- Children may bring electronic devices or other entertainment for break periods, but these devices will not be permitted to be used during rehearsals.
- WE DO NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY for loss of property ~ students are responsible for their own belongings. Students can utilize our lockers to help keep their belongings in one place ©
- Costumes will either be provided or will be items that the students can bring from home. We will send home notes at the end of each day if there are particular items we need the children to bring along the next day.

STUDENT & PARENT EXPECTATIONS:

- Participants will attend every class and be prepared for rehearsal by practicing their role at home (particularly if a lead role).
- Participants agree to conduct themselves in a positive way during all rehearsals and to be supportive of their fellow crew members, no matter what role they are given.
- Students who engage in disruptive or bullying type behavior will be given one warning and
 opportunity to fix their behavior before being removed from the program. Parents will be notified of
 the warning immediately. In the instance of a student being removed from the program, a refund of
 registration fees WILL NOT BE GIVEN.
- Due to the wide range of ages involved in the show, we ask that older children be sensitive to the needs and comfort of younger children. Always be kind and caring and strive to be excellent role models for the younger students.
